Monthly total and cumulative recruitment graph

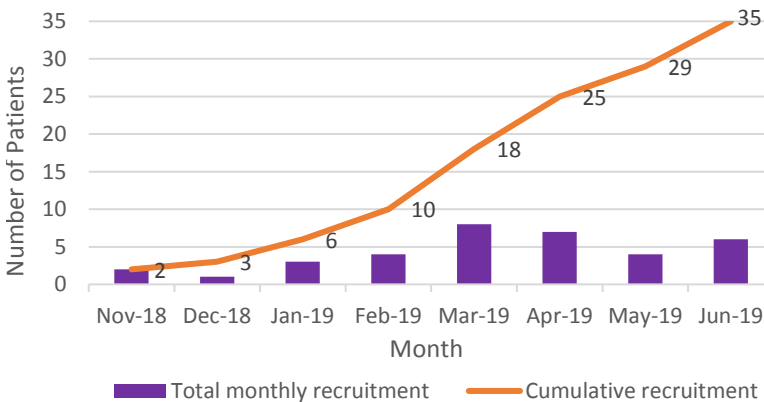


Figure 1. Line graph showing total monthly and cumulative patient recruitment. Study target: 1000 participants.
