- Please provide the **correct baseline questionnaires** to patients. Check footer of questionnaire before handing to patient:
 - ‘C_BASE’ → For control participants
 - ‘ES_BASE’ → For patients having early salpingectomy
 - ‘DO_BASE’ → For patients having delayed oophorectomy
 - ‘SO_BASE’ → For patients having risk-reducing salpingo-oophorectomy

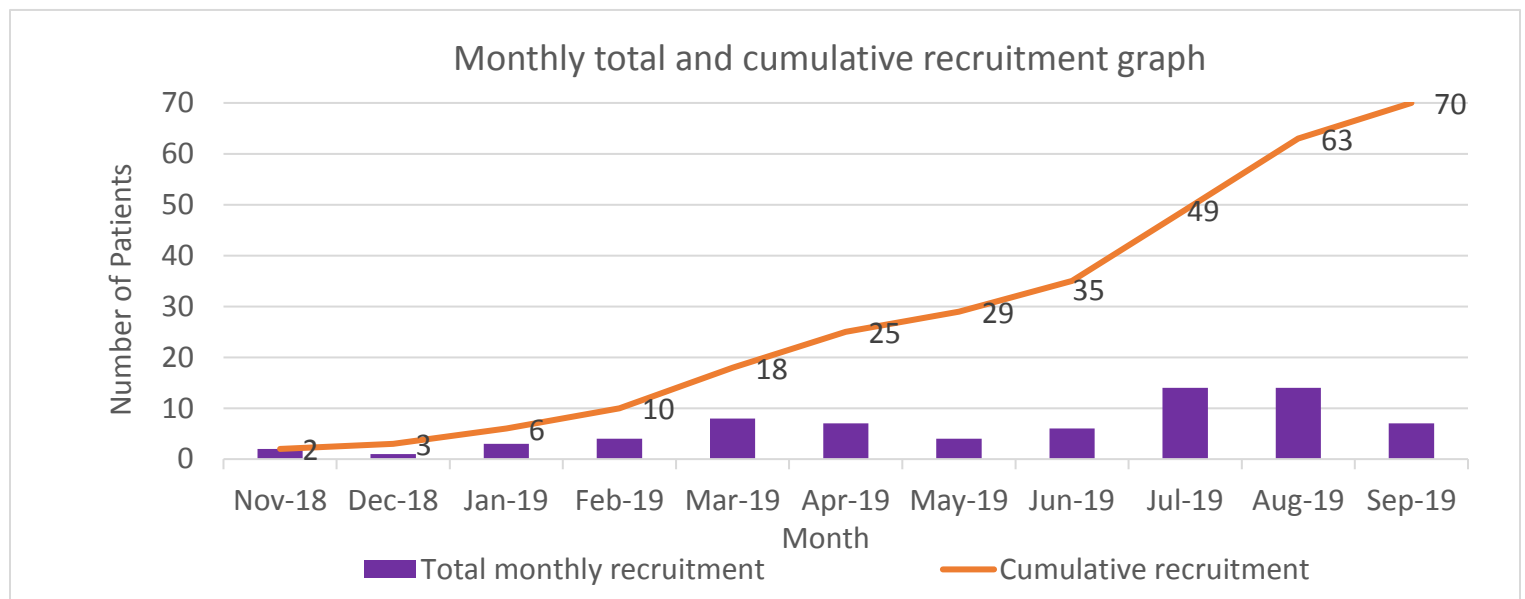


Figure 1. Line graph showing total monthly and cumulative patient recruitment. Study target: 1000 participants.
